

Nico Bruns is Professor of Sustainable Functional Polymers at the Technical University of Darmstadt, Germany. He received his PhD in Macromolecular Chemistry from the University of Freiburg, Germany, was a postdoc at the University of California, Berkeley, USA, and then moved to the University of Basel, Switzerland, for his Habilitation. From 2013 to 2018 he was Associate Professor of Macromolecular Chemistry at the Adolphe-Merkle-Institute of the University of Fribourg, Switzerland, and between 2018 and 2021 Professor of Macromolecular Chemistry at the University of Strathclyde, Glasgow, UK. His research interests are biocatalysis in polymer chemistry, stimuli-responsive polymersomes, and bio-inspired materials.
